- There will be approximately 10 assignments and 2 quizzes.
- You must be passing the unit (70% or better) at the mid-term (April 12) in order to continue with the unit. Your grade at that point will consist of your assignment completion grade (75%) and the quiz grade (25%). All quizzes and assignments will be open book/open notes. You will be encouraged to collaborate with at least one other person.
- You may withdraw from the class at any time. Just inform me that you are dropping the course.
- All assignments will be due on the day indicated regardless of whether or not you were in class on the day assigned. It is your responsibility to obtain in a timely manner any notes or assignments missed. You will be able to download all assignments and class notes from the ACE Website. Late assignments, which may be turned in to either directly to Mr. Easton or to your Science/Algebra teacher, will be accepted as follows:

1 day late (Wednesday after due date):	75% of your earned grade
2 days late (Thursday after due date):	50% of your earned grade
3 or more days late:	0% of your earned grade

Any exceptions to these policies must be approved by Mr. Easton in advance

Bush Gardens Field Trip: Because of the “no field trip policy”, the field trip to Busch Gardens may have to be on a Saturday. The date is yet to be determined, though Jun 11th may be the best day. And of course, school furnished transportation will not be available. Therefore:

- Students must furnish their own transportation to and from Busch Gardens.

- Students must be accompanied by school chaperones (Mr. Easton, Mrs. Gregory, or designated adult) at all times.
- Family members only may join us, but Mrs. Gregory and I will chaperone from park opening (10 A.M.) until 5 P.M.. At 5 P.M. you must be met by a parent or other authorized adult.
